**ORDER APPROVING
TARIFF REVISIONS**

On April 13, 2009, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) for approval to revise its tariffed Summary of Contracts with Deviations. The existing contract with the City of Roslyn expired on April 1, 2009. Otter Tail states the new agreement does not contain any deviations from Otter Tail's currently filed tariff and therefore requests that reference to a contract with the City of Roslyn be removed from the Summary of Contracts with Deviations. Otter Tail filed the following tariff sheet for Commission approval:

Section No. 4, Twelfth Revised Sheet No. 3, Canceling Eleventh Revised Sheet No. 3.

At its June 9, 2009, meeting, the Commission considered the request for approval of the revised tariff sheet. Commission Staff recommended approval.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, and 49-34A-11. Further, the Commission finds that Otter Tail's request for approval of tariff revisions is just and reasonable and shall be approved. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that the request seeking approval of tariff revisions is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED, that the above referenced tariff sheet is effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 2009.
