On May 12, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) for approval to revise its tariffed Summary of Contracts with Deviations. The existing contract with Ward, South Dakota, listed as a contract with deviations has expired. Otter Tail stated the new agreement, as of May 1, 2011, does not contain any deviations from Otter Tail's currently filed tariff rates and therefore requested the reference to a contract with the Town of Ward be removed from the Summary of Contracts with Deviations. On May 18, 2011, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 3, 2011, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention. The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-9, 49-34A-10, and 49-34A-12; and ARSD 20:10:13:09 and 20:10:13:15.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of June 14, 2011, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff recommended approval of Otter Tail's request to revise its tariffed Summary of Contracts with Deviations. The Commission finds the revisions are proper and approves the revisions. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Otter Tail's request to revise its tariffed Summary of Contract with Deviations, as described above, is hereby granted.
