**ORDER DISMISSING AND

On December 22, 2016, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Trinity Point Limited Partnership. This filing requests approval of a variance from the individual metering requirements in ARSD 20:10:26:03.

On December 29, 2016, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of January 13, 2017, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. On January 5, 2017, Commission staff filed a request to dismiss and close the docket as a Gas & Electric docket was created to take the place of EL16-041.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on January 17, 2017, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss and close the docket. It is therefore
