ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF SETTLEMENT STIPULATION

EL17-006

On February 15, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application by Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy (BHE) for Approval of its 2017 Transmission Facilities Adjustment (TFA). BHE seeks approval of the annual true-up of the actual amounts collected in the third year of the TFA, as approved in Docket EL16-005, and the forecasted recovery of revenue requirements associated with the fourth year of the TFA. BHE proposes TFA rates effective June 1, 2017, through May 31, 2018. Approximately 68,000 South Dakota customers are affected by the TFA rate change. The bill increase for a typical residential customer averaging 650 kWh per month would be approximately 0.02 percent.

On February 16, 2017, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of March 3, 2017, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. As of the date of this order, no petitions to intervene or comments had been filed. On March 1, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Assessing Filing Fee. On March 29, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Operation of Rate Schedule. On June 9, 2017, a Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation, Settlement Stipulation, and Staff Memorandum Supporting Settlement Stipulation were filed with the Commission.

The revised tariff sheets attached to the Settlement Stipulation effective for service rendered on and after July 1, 2017, are as follows:

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, 49-34A-11, 49-34A-12, 49-34A-25.1 through 49-34A-25.4, and ARSD 20:10:01:19.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on June 16, 2017, the Commission considered this matter. Having thoroughly reviewed the filings in the docket, the Commission found that the terms and conditions proposed in the Settlement Stipulation were just, reasonable, and in the public interest and that good and sufficient cause was demonstrated to approved the Settlement Stipulation. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the Joint Motion for Approval of the Settlement Stipulation. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation is granted. The Settlement Stipulation is incorporated by reference into this Order the same as if it had been set forth in its entirety herein. It is further

ORDERED, that the aforementioned tariff sheets are approved with an effective date of July 1, 2017.
