On May 21, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) requesting approval of changes to customer information contained in pamphlets distributed to new customers. MidAmerican is requesting Commission approval as soon as possible.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:16:02, a utility must submit a copy of customer information to the Commission for approval before it can be distributed.

MidAmerican proposed to make several changes to the pamphlet such as revising gas rates, updating the cover page, updating the ECA, and expanding the phone number list. After reviewing the proposed changes, Commission Staff recommended several revisions to the new pamphlets.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of June 8, 1999, the Commission considered approval of the changes. Following MidAmerican's compliance with the proposed revisions, Commission Staff recommended approval of the changes.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, 49-34A-11 and ARSD 20:10:16:02. The Commission approves the changes, voting 2-0. It is therefore

ORDERED, that MidAmerican's above mentioned changes to customer information pamphlets are hereby approved and shall be effective on the date of this order.
