



The Commission, after examining the evidence and hearing testimony presented by the parties, shall make Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and a Final Decision. As a result of the hearing, the Commission may suspend or revoke Wheetco's grain dealer's license, or, if not suspended or revoked, impose any other requirements or restrictions. The Final Decision made by the Commission may be appealed by the parties to the state Circuit Court and the state Supreme Court as provided by law.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that a hearing shall be held on the above-listed issue at 8:30 A.M., on Friday, September 8, 2000, in Room 413 of the State Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota.
