On July 29, 2005, MidAmerican Energy Company filed an application seeking approval of revisions to its Firm Monthly Metered Transportation Gas Pilot Project. The proposed revisions would increase the administrative charge to reflect the annual true up and add language to provide more description of the program. The revised tariff sheets are as follows:

ORDERED, that the above referenced tariffs are approved and are effective for service rendered on and after September 1, 2005.
