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IN THE MATTER OF THE FILING BY NORTHWESTERN ENERGY FOR APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT WITH DEVIATIONS WITH REDFIELD ENERGY, LLC ORDER APPROVING CONTRACT WITH DEVIATIONS AND APPROVING TARIFF REVISIONS NG07-005

On March 9, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by NorthWestern Energy (NWE) requesting approval of a contract with deviations and associated tariff revisions. NWE is proposing to adopt the contract that was in effect between Redfield Energy, LLC and NorthWestern Services Group. The rate that is currently contracted between the customer and NWE will not change. The original contract was dated July 19, 2006, with a term of 15 years beginning at plant start-up. Over the past year, NWE has evaluated its non-regulated businesses and has looked at the strategic value of each entity versus the resources that are dedicated to these business units. After a thorough evaluation of the non-regulated gas business in SD/NE, it has been decided by the Northwestern Services, LLC management committee to execute a strategy to shift the majority of this business (Nekota Resources, LLC) into the regulated utility and look at alternatives to divest the rest of this business. NWE filed the following tariff sheet for Commission approval:

Section No. 4, 14th Revised Sheet No. 1, Canceling 13th Revised Sheet No. 1

On March 27, 2007, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered the request for approval of the Contract with Deviations. Commission Staff recommended approval.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-8.3, 49-34A-10, and 49-34A-11. Further, the Commission finds that NWE's request for approval of a Contract with Deviations is just and reasonable and shall be approved, with the condition that this approval does not predetermine a Commission decision at the time of future rate case proceedings regarding rate treatment concerning possible cost recovery shortfalls resulting from rates approved in this docket. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that the request seeking approval of a Contract with Deviations is in the public interest and is hereby granted, with the condition that this approval does not predetermine a Commission decision at the time of future rate case proceedings regarding rate treatment concerning possible cost recovery shortfalls resulting from rates approved in this docket; and it is further

ORDERED, that the above-mentioned tariff is approved and is effective April 1, 2007.
