On March 9, 2009, the Commission received a request to open a rulemaking docket and receive public comment from Commission Pipeline Safety Staff. Staff requested that the Commission allow a 30 day formal comment period for operators and a 10 day staff reply opportunity prior to the scheduling of a hearing mid-summer 2009.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34B-19.

The Commission voted unanimously to approve a 30 day formal comment period for operators and a 10 day staff reply opportunity prior to the scheduling of a hearing mid-summer 2009. It is therefore

ORDERED, that a 30 day formal comment period for operators and a 10 day staff reply opportunity prior to the scheduling of a hearing mid-summer 2009 is hereby approved. The 30 day formal comment period shall begin to run from the date this Order is received by the operators and the 10 day staff reply opportunity will begin to run from the date comments are received by staff.
