

The Commission, after examining the evidence and hearing testimony presented by the parties, shall make Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and a Final Decision. As a result of the hearing, the Commission may determine whether U S WEST committed an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission and may determine damages,

finer or other remedies for service quality as provided by law. The Final Decision may be appealed by the parties to the Circuit Court and the South Dakota Supreme Court as provided by law. It is therefore

ORDERED that a hearing shall be held on the complaint of Cathy Feickert as specified above.
