On November 18, 1996, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, received an application for a certificate of authority from Affinity Marketing Strategies LLC d/b/a Funding Our Future (Affinity).

Affinity intends to resell long distance telecommunications services of underlying carrier LDDS/WorldCom d/b/a Wiltel. Affinity is not a facilities based carrier and will offer its services throughout the United States, including the entire state of South Dakota. A proposed tariff was filed by Affinity. The Commission has classified long distance service as fully competitive.

On December 5, 1996, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of December 20, 1996, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed and a regularly scheduled February 11, 1997, meeting, the Commission considered Affinity's request for a certificate of authority. Commission Staff recommended granting a certificate of authority, subject to the condition that Affinity not offer a prepaid calling card or require deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02 and 20:10:24:03. The Commission finds that Affinity has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. Affinity has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota. The Commission approves Affinity's application for a certificate of authority, subject to the condition that Affinity not offer a prepaid calling card or require deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that Affinity's application for a certificate of authority is hereby granted, subject to the condition that Affinity not offer a prepaid calling card or require deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Affinity shall file informational copies of tariff changes with the Commission as the changes occur.
