On May 20, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Petition to Adopt Discount Rates Implemented by the Federal Communications Commission for Interstate Telecommunications Services for Schools and Libraries from Commission Staff. The petition requests the Commission to adopt the discount rates implemented by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) for interstate telecommunications services for schools and libraries as the discount rates for intrastate telecommunications services provided for schools and libraries. The FCC Order implementing the Telecommunications Act of 1996 states that in order for a state to receive Federal Universal Service Funds for discounts to schools and libraries it must have intrastate discount rates in place at least equal to the interstate discount rates.

Staff requests that the following discount matrix, which the FCC adopted using the school lunch eligibility program to calculate the poverty level of both schools and libraries, be adopted as the schools and libraries discount to be used by South Dakota:
