IN THE MATTER OF THE FILING BY THE LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIERS ASSOCIATION FOR SWITCHED ACCESS TARIFF REVISIONS

ORDER SUSPENDING ACCESS TARIFF TC97-061

On June 2, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by the Local Exchange Carriers Association (LECA) regarding its switched access tariff revisions. The purpose of these revisions is to implement the changes in rates as necessitated by member companies' revenue requirements as set forth in Commission filings. The rates are proposed to be effective July 1, 1997.

On June 5, 1997, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 20, 1997, to interested individuals and entities.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of June 24, 1997, the Commission unanimously voted to suspend the effective date of LECA's switched access rate for no more than 120 days after the proposed effective date of July 1, 1997.

The commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31, specifically 49-31-12.4, 49-31-18, 49-31-19 and ARSD 20:10:27:07 and 20:10:27:08.

It is therefore

ORDERED that the effective date for LECA's switched access rate be suspended for no more than 120 days from the proposed effective date.
