On June 4, 1997, Midstate Telephone Company (Midstate) filed for approval by the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) its 1996 Intrastate Switched Access Cost Study. On November 12, 1997, Midstate filed its revised Cost Study.

On June 5, 1997, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 20, 1997, to interested individuals and entities. On June 19, 1997, the Commission received a Petition for Leave to Intervene from U S WEST Communications, Inc. (U S WEST). The Commission granted U S WEST's Petition to Intervene. The Commission also voted to assess a \$1,000 filing fee. On November 18, 1997, the Commission granted U S WEST's motion for withdrawal from this docket. The Commission considered this matter at its January 8, 1998, meeting. Commission Staff recommended approval of the revised revenue requirement.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 1-26-17.1, 49-1A-9, 49-31-12.4, 49-31-12.6, 49-31-18, 49-31-19 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.02, 20:10:01:15.05, 20:10:27:07 and 20:10:27:08. Upon review of Midstate's filings, the Commission found that the revised revenue requirement was fair and reasonable and should be approved. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED that Midstate's revenue requirement is hereby approved as revised and shall be incorporated in the Local Exchange Carriers Association's determination of switched access rates. (See TC97-061.)
