On July 27, 1998, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, received an application for a certificate of authority from Alliance Group Services, Inc. (Alliance).

Alliance seeks authority to operate as a reseller of intrastate telecommunications services on a statewide basis. Such services include a full range of "1+" services, MTS, out-WATS, in-WATS and calling card services. A proposed tariff was filed by Alliance. The Commission has classified long distance service as fully competitive.

On July 30, 1998, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of August 14, 1998, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed and at its regularly scheduled December 7, 1998, meeting, the Commission considered Alliance's request for a certificate of authority. Commission Staff recommended granting a certificate of authority.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02 and 20:10:24:03. The Commission finds that Alliance has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. Alliance has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota. The Commission approves Alliance's application for a certificate of authority. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that Alliance's application for a certificate of authority is hereby granted. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Alliance shall file informational copies of tariff changes with the Commission as the changes occur.
