On February 9, 1998, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, received an application for a certificate of authority from Satellink Paging, LLC (Satellink).

Satellink proposes to offer 1+ direct dialing, 800 toll free, travel card and outbound dialing as an adjunct to its paging and voice mail services. A proposed tariff was filed by Satellink. The Commission has classified long distance service as fully competitive.

On February 12, 1998, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of February 27, 1998, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed and at its regularly scheduled March 26, 1998, meeting, the Commission considered Satellink's request for a certificate of authority. Commission Staff recommended granting a certificate of authority, subject to the condition that Satellink not offer a prepaid calling card or require deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02 and 20:10:24:03. The Commission finds that Satellink has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. Satellink has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota. The Commission approves Satellink's application for a certificate of authority, subject to the condition that Satellink not offer a prepaid calling card or require deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that Satellink's application for a certificate of authority is hereby granted effective April 9, 1998, subject to the condition that Satellink not offer a prepaid calling card or require deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Satellink shall file informational copies of tariff changes with the Commission as the changes occur.
