At its December 28, 1999, meeting, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) voted unanimously to order OLS, Inc. (OLS) to provide the Commission with a list of all of its current South Dakota subscribers pursuant to SDCL 49-31-95. SDCL 49-31-95 provides that if the Commission receives more than two complaints within thirty days alleging unauthorized switching or billing of subscribers, the Commission may require the company complained against to provide the Commission with a complete list of its current subscribers, including the subscribers' billing addresses. Since September 1, 1999, the Commission has received 31 formal complaints and 536 informal complaints against OLS alleging the unauthorized switching or billing of subscribers. OLS was to provide the Commission with a current list of its South Dakota subscribers along with their billing addresses on or before February 8, 2000.

On January 27, 2000, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities.

On February 8, 2000, the Commission received a Submission of List and Request for Confidentiality from OLS.

At a regularly scheduled meeting of October 23, 2001, Commission Staff recommended that the docket be closed. The Commission voted to close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the docket shall be closed.
