On March 20, 2006, Sprint Long Distance, Inc. (Sprint) filed an application with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for a certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in South Dakota.

On May 11, 2006, Sprint requested that its application for a certificate of authority be withdrawn.

At its regularly scheduled May 23, 2006, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD Chapters 20:10:24 and 20:10:32. The Commission found that Sprint's request to withdraw its request for a certificate of authority is reasonable and closed the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Sprint shall be permitted to withdraw its request for a certificate of authority, and it is further

ORDERED, that this docket is closed.
