On September 11, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a request from Granite Telecommunications, LLC (Granite) for approval of an extension of its exemption from the requirement to develop intrastate switched access rates based on company specific costs.

On November 6, 2007, the Commission considered Granite's request for approval of an extension of its exemption from establishing switched access rates based on company specific costs. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31-18, 49-31-19, and ARSD 20:10:27:11. The Commission voted to grant an extension of its exemption. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Granite is approved for an extension of its exemption from establishing company specific cost-based switched access rates and allowed Granite to modify its switched access tariff so long as Granite's intrastate switched access rate is equal to or less than that of the ILEC Qwest intrastate switched access rate or until the Commission shall otherwise order.
