On October 24, 2006, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an Application from Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) for authority to provide local exchange services in certain rural areas served by Interstate Telecommunications Cooperative, Inc. (ITC).

On October 26, 2006, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of November 10, 2006, to interested individuals and entities. South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA) filed to intervene on November 7, 2006. ITC filed to intervene on November 8, 2006. ITC was granted intervention. SDTA was granted intervention subject to certain restrictions. On March 30, 2007, the Commission issued an Order Setting Procedural Schedule; Order for and Notice of Hearing scheduling the hearing to be held on June 26, 2007. On May 4, 2007, the Commission received a Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing. At its regularly scheduled meeting of May 22, 2007, the Commission unanimously voted to grant the Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing. On July 5, 2007, the Commission received a Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing. At its meeting on July 11, 2007, the Commission granted the Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing. On January 11, 2008, the Commission received a Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing.

At its January 29, 2008, meeting, the Commission considered the Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing. Commission Staff recommended approval. The Commission unanimously voted to grant the Joint Motion for Delay of Hearing. On May 13, 2008, the Commission received a Motion to Request the Commission Enter a Protective Order.

At its May 20, 2008, meeting, the Commission considered the Motion to Request the Commission Enter a Protective Order. All parties agreed to entry of the Order. Commission Staff recommended approval. The Commission unanimously voted to grant the Motion to Request the Commission Enter a Protective Order.

The parties have agreed to pre-file testimony according to the following schedule:

Pursuant to an Order for and Notice of Hearing dated May 28, 2008, the hearing in this matter has been scheduled to begin at 9:00 A.M. on August 20, 2008, and continuing at 8:00 A.M. on August 21-22, 2008, in the Visitors Center, 650 East Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31, specifically SDCL 49-31-69 through 49-31-75, inclusive. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the parties shall follow the scheduling order as set forth above.
