**ORDER GRANTING
WITHDRAWAL OF
INTERVENTION**

On September 17, 2007, PrairieWave Community Telephone, Inc. (PrairieWave) filed a petition requesting an exemption from filing company specific cost-based switched access rates.

On September 20, 2007, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of October 5, 2007, to interested individuals and entities. On October 10, 2007, the Commission received a Petition to Intervene from AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T).

At a regularly scheduled meeting of October 23, 2007, the Commission granted intervention to AT&T. On December 14, 2007, the Commission received an Amended Petition for Exemption from PrairieWave. On December 31, 2007, the Commission received a Response to Amended Petition for Exemption from AT&T. On March 21, 2008, the Commission received a Motion to Withdraw Intervention from AT&T.

On March 19, 2008, PrairieWave informed the Commission that its name is now Knology of Community Telephone, Inc.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.05.

At a regularly scheduled meeting of March 25, 2008, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission found that AT&T's Motion to Withdraw Intervention should be granted. It is therefore

ORDERED, that AT&T's Motion to Withdraw Intervention is hereby granted.
