On December 18, 2007, the Commission received for approval an Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement between Interstate Telecommunications Cooperative, Inc. (ITC) and Rural Cellular Corporation (Rural Cellular).

On December 20, 2007, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until January 7, 2008, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its duly noticed January 29, 2008, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the agreement between ITC and Rural Cellular. Commission Staff recommended its approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement and the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the agreement.
