On November 25, 2008, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Complaint from OrbitCom, Inc. (OrbitCom) against Verizon Business Network Services, Inc. (Verizon). OrbitCom seeks recovery on an account because of the failure of Verizon to pay OrbitCom the amounts invoiced pursuant to its state tariff for the provisioning of telephone access services.

On December 22, 2008, the Commission received an Answer to Complaint from Verizon. On June 1, 2009, the Commission received a Stipulation for Scheduling Order signed by the parties.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31. The Commission may rely upon any or all of these or other laws of this state in making its determination.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of June 9, 2009, the Commission considered the Stipulation for Scheduling Order. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the Stipulation for Scheduling Order. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Stipulation for Scheduling Order is hereby approved.
