On April 28, 2009, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a petition from Wireless Alliance, LLC d/b/a Unicel (WALLC) for approval to relinquish its eligible telecommunications carrier designation through its entire South Dakota designated ETC area. WALLC stated that it will continue to offer and provide wireless service throughout its licensed area in the state of South Dakota.

On April 30, 2009, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of May 15, 2009, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, specifically SDCL 49-31-78.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on June 9, 2009, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to approve WALLC's Relinquishment of its Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier, effective August 1, 2009, or 45 days from the date WALLC sends a letter to its customers regarding this relinquishment, whichever occurs first. It is therefore

ORDERED, that WALLC's Relinquishment of its Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier is hereby approved, effective August 1, 2009, or 45 days from the date WALLC sends a letter to its customers regarding this relinquishment, whichever occurs first.
