**ORDER APPROVING
AMENDMENT TO
AGREEMENT**

On May 20, 2010, the Commission received a filing for approval of a four-party transit traffic amendment to the wireline interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and Neutral Tandem, Inc. (Neutral Tandem) for the state of South Dakota. The Commission did not receive any comments on this matter

At its June 15, 2010, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the agreement between Qwest and Neutral Tandem. Commission Staff recommended its approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement and the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the four-party transit traffic amendment to the wireline interconnection agreement between Qwest and Neutral Tandem.
