ORDER APPROVING AMENDED REVENUE POOLING DOCUMENTS TC11-070

On June 8, 2011, the Fiber Ring Revenue-Pooling Association (FRRPA) filed a Petition to seek Commission approval for the addition of an Ethernet Traffic Class to the FRRPA Ring User LECs' (RUL) Contracts that will become effective July 15, 2009.

On June 9, 2011, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing and the intervention deadline of June 24, 2011, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 9, 2011, the Commission considered whether to approve the petition and the amended revenue pooling documents. Commission Staff recommended approval with the condition that approval in this docket does not preclude the Commission from making any adjustments in the individual switched access cost studies related to FRRPA's revenues, expenses, or plant.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-59.1. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the petition, with the condition that approval in this docket does not preclude the Commission from making any adjustments in the individual switched access cost studies related to FRRPA's revenues, expenses, or plant. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves FRRPA's Petition and the amended revenue pooling documents with the condition that approval in this docket does not preclude the Commission from making any adjustments in the individual switched access cost studies related to FRRPA's revenues, expenses, or plant.
