On July 7, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from the Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC (Qwest) for changes to its Exchange and Network Tariff No. 1 which propose the approval of Qwest's fictitious name. The filing includes adoption notice, and a revised title, application of tariff, and trademark page reflecting the d/b/a CenturyLink QC. On July 14, 2011, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 29, 2011, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention. On August 10, 2011, Qwest filed revised tariff pages reflecting an effective date of August 24, 2011.
