On December 16, 2011, Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) filed an application with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval of revisions to its South Dakota P.U.C. Tariff No. 3. The filing was made pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, in WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 11-161. The changes implement provisions governing Voice over Internet Protocol telephony – Public Switched Telephone Network (VoIP-PSTN) Traffic. On December 22, 2011, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of January 6, 2012, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.
