## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On May 18, 2012, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Local Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. (LECA) for approval of revisions to its Access Services Tariff No. 1. The purpose of this filing is to implement the Federal Communication Commission's Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order (November 18, 2011). On May 24, 2012, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the request and the intervention deadline of June 8, 2012, to interested individuals and entities. On May 30, 2012, AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed its Petition to Intervene.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.05.

At a regularly scheduled meeting of June 5, 2012, LECA stated it did not object to granting AT&T's Petition to Intervene. The Commission found that AT&T's Petition to Intervene demonstrated good cause to grant intervention and voted unanimously to grant intervention to AT&T. It is therefore

ORDERED, that AT&T's Petition to Intervene is hereby granted.
