ORDER APPROVING  
TARIFF REVISIONS

On June 27, 2014, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Sancom, Inc. dba Mitchell Telecom (Sancom) requesting approval for revisions to its Intrastate Switched Access Services Tariff No.1. This filing is in order to implement the Federal Communications Commission's, November 18, 2011, Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order (FCC 11-161). Sancom requests the proposed changes become effective July 1, 2014. On July 3, 2014, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 18, 2014, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention. On July 14, 2014, Sancom responded to Staff's data requests.

The following Tariff No. 1 pages were filed for Commission approval:

Seventh Revised Page 1, Cancels Sixth Revised Page 1  
Second Revised Page 17-5, Cancels First Revised Page 17-5

At its regularly scheduled meeting on August 19, 2014, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. Commission Staff recommended approval. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the revisions to Sancom's Tariff No. 1. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the above-referenced pages of Sancom's Tariff No. 1 with an effective date of July 1, 2014.
