ORDER APPROVING IN THE MATTER OF THE APPROVAL OF AN INTERCARRIER COMPENSATION BILL AMENDMENT TO **AGREEMENT AMENDMENT** TO AND KEEP INTERCONNECTION **AGREEMENT** BETWEEN QWEST CORPORATION DBA TC17-011 CENTURYLINK QC **AND NEUTRAL** TANDEM-SOUTH DAKOTA, LLC

On April 4, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252 for approval of a Name Correction and Reciprocal Compensation Bill and Keep Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) and Neutral Tandem, Inc. (Tandem) for the State of South Dakota.

On April 6, 2017, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listsery. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until April 24, 2017, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its April 27, 2017, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated amendment to the agreement between CenturyLink and Tandem. Commission staff recommended approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission found that the amendment to the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the interconnection agreement between CenturyLink and Tandem.
