On June 7, 2017, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from South Dakota Network, LLC (SDN) for waiver of the requirement to file a switched access cost study as required by Commission rule ARSD 20:10:27:07. SDN requests the waiver of the cost study requirement because of the costs and resources involved in producing a study and a preliminary analysis indicates that a cost study would support higher rates.

On June 8, 2017, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 23, 2017, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On June 29, 2017, SDN responded to staff's data request.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:27:02 and 20:10:27:07.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 1, 2017, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff recommended granting SDN's waiver. The Commission found good cause to grant the requested waiver. It is therefore

ORDERED, that SDN's request for a waiver, pursuant to ARSD 20:10:27:02, of the requirement to perform a switched access cost study is hereby granted.
