On July 13, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Clarity Telecom, LLC d/b/a Vast Broadband (Clarity) requesting approval of revisions to its Access Service Tariff No. 3. Clarity is submitting this filing to be in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's November 11, 2011, Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order (FCC 11-161). Clarity requests that the tariff revisions become effective on July 1, 2017.

On July 20, 2017, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of August 4, 2017, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No parties sought intervention.

The following South Dakota Access Service Tariff No. 3 page was filed for Commission approval:

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 15, 2017, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the requested revisions to Clarity's Access Service Tariff No. 3 with a July 1, 2017, effective date. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Clarity Access Service Tariff No. 3 revisions are approved, effective as of July 1, 2017.
