IN THE MATTER OF THE APPROVAL OF A WIRELINE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN QWEST CORPORATION DBA CENTURYLINK QC AND WIDE VOICE, LLC ORDER APPROVING AGREEMENT

On March 7, 2018, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252 for approval of the Wireline Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Wide Voice LLC.

On March 8, 2018, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the agreement to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until March 27, 2018, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of April 3, 2018, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Wide Voice LLC. Commission staff recommended approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement and the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the Wireline Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Wide Voice LLC.
