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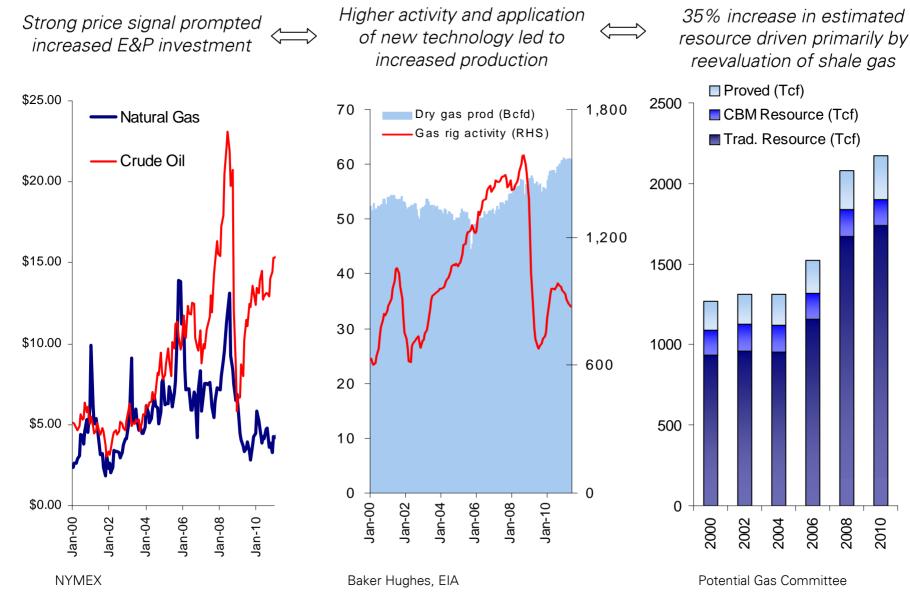
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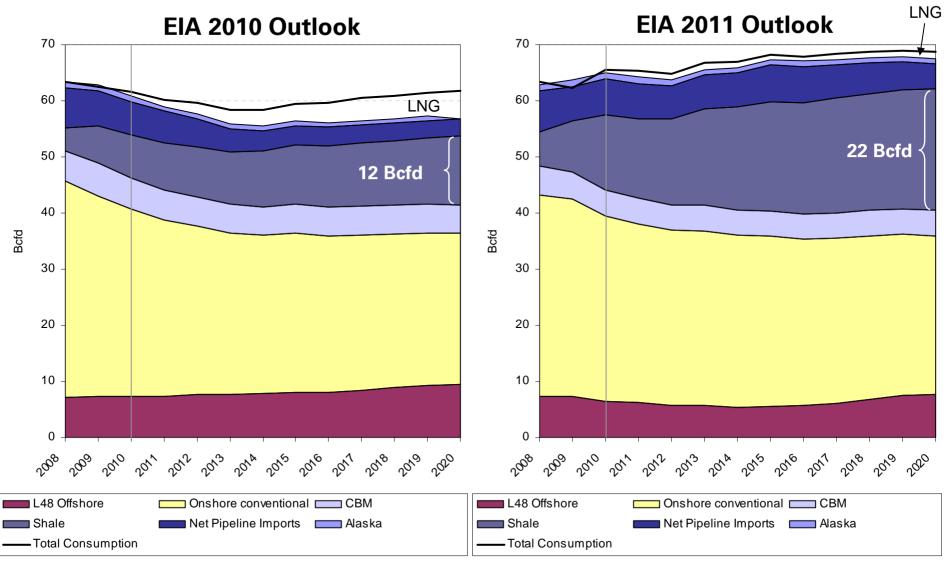

Long-term US natural gas balances: What a difference a year makes

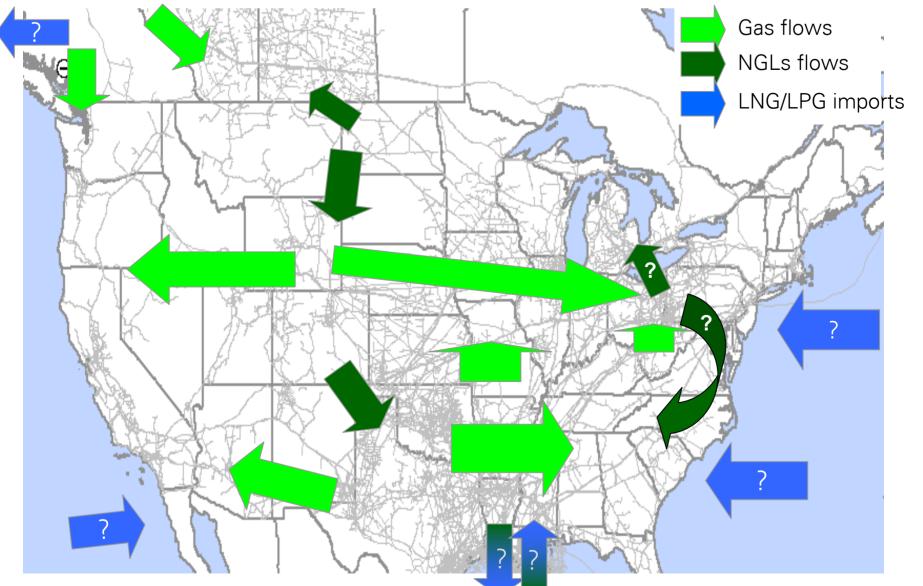

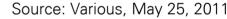
Regional gas & NGL flow dynamics are evolving

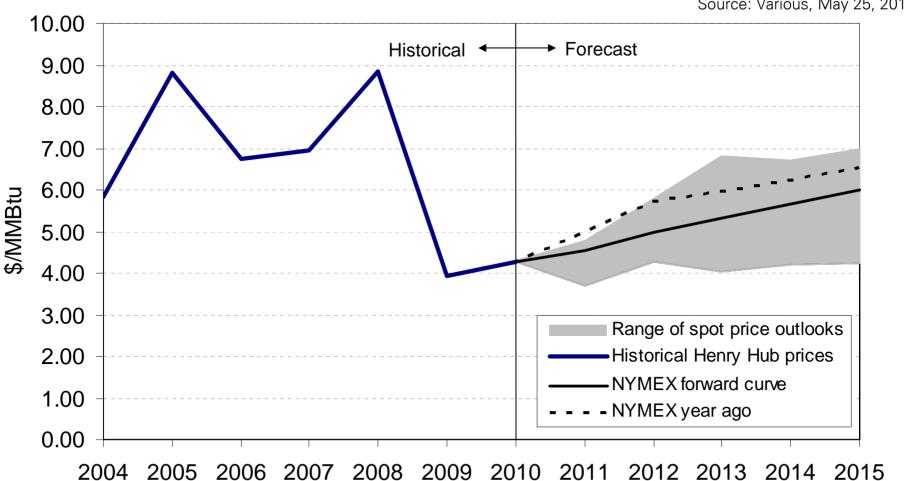




Long-Term Henry Hub spot price outlooks
