

South Dakota Renewable and Recycled Energy Objective

2008 Annual Report MidAmerican Energy Company

MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) files the following report in compliance with SDCL 49-34A-105 covering the twelve-month period ending on September 30, 2008.

Qualifying Energy Delivered:

For the twelve-month period ending on September 30, 2008, MidAmerican had 200,883 MWh of electric sales to customers in South Dakota. The portfolio of electricity generation that was utilized in supplying these sales resulted in 0.59% of the energy being from renewable energy sources.

Renewable and Recycled Energy Certificates Purchases and Retired as a Percent of the Annual Retail Sales:

MidAmerican purchased and retired no renewable or recycled energy certificates for its South Dakota regulated retail customers during the period. MidAmerican did sell renewable energy certificates during the period; however, the energy associated with the sales of these renewable energy certificates is not included as being from renewable sources in this report.

Brief Narrative Report Describing Steps Taken and Challenges or Barriers:

MidAmerican currently is the nation's leader in owned wind generation by a rate-regulated utility and continues to take steps to increase the amount of renewable energy generation capacity in its generation portfolio. By the end of 2008, MidAmerican's generating capacity will include approximately 20 percent renewable generation. Production Tax Credits and the sale of renewable energy credits both help to promote the further development of renewable projects.
