Re: Coyote Ridge Wind Project (the "Project")

To whom it may concern:

I am writing to inform you per the requirements of the South Dakota Codified Law 49-41B-25.1 that Avangrid Renewables LLC is starting construction in October 2018 of the Coyote Ridge Wind Farm in Brookings County, South Dakota. The Coyote Ridge Wind Project is located 3 miles east of White, SD with turbines in Oaklake and Sherman Townships. The project is approximately 97MW and will house 39 General Electric turbines, made in the USA, and components are expected to arrive at the site in June 2019. The project will interconnect to Xcel Energy's transmission system at the Brookings Substation. The commercial operation date is anticipated to be December 1st, 2019. Construction should be completed by second quarter 2020.
