On April 1, 2015, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Black Hills Power, Inc. (BHP) requesting approval of its 2015 Economic Development Plan and Budget. This filing is made in accordance with the approved Amended Settlement Stipulation in Docket EL14-026. The Amended Settlement Stipulation requires BHP to provide an annual report that describes the costs, design, and benefit of its economic development program. On April 2, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 17, 2015, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listsery. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On May 8, 2015, BHP responded to staff's data requests 1-1 through 1-8.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically SDCL 49-34A-4 and 49-34A-6.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 26, 2015, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff recommended approval of BHP's proposed Economic Development Plan and Budget for 2015. After review of the application, the Commission found it to be just and reasonable and voted unanimously to approve BHP's 2015 Economic Development Plan and Budget. It is therefore

ORDERED, that BHP's 2015 Economic Development Plan and Budget are approved as filed, with the customer contribution limited as provided in the Amended Settlement Stipulation as set forth in the Plan.
