Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:16:02, the customer information shall be submitted to the Commission for approval. Xcel redesigned its welcome brochures for both residential and business customers. On July 15, 2015, Xcel responded to Staff data requests and submitted a Revised Residential Welcome Brochure and a Revised Business Welcome Brochure at the request of Staff.

On June 11, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 26, 2015, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, particularly 49-34A-10, and ARSD 20:10:16:02.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 5, 2015, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff recommended approval of the revisions to the brochures and approval of the Revised Residential Welcome Brochure and Revised Business Welcome Brochure. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the Revised Residential Welcome Brochure and Revised Business Welcome Brochure. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Revised Residential Welcome Brochure and Revised Business Welcome Brochure are hereby approved.
