On September 18, 2015, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a letter from NorthWestern Corporation dba NorthWestern Energy (NorthWestern) requesting approval of revisions to its Fuel Adjustment Clause tariff. NorthWestern proposes to credit the Production Tax Credits (PTCs) from the Beethoven Wind Facility to its electric customers through the Fuel Adjustment Clause tariff. NorthWestern anticipates closing on the Beethoven Wind Facility before October 1, 2015, and thus requests approval with less than 30 days' notice to begin the inclusion of the PTCs in NorthWestern's Fuel Adjustment Clause on October 1, 2015. On September 24, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of September 28, 2015, to interested persons on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listsery. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A and ARSD 20:10:13:20 and 20:10:13:21.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on September 29, 2015, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval of the tariff revisions. Finding the revisions to be just and reasonable, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the revisions with less than 30 days' notice. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above-referenced tariff sheet is approved on less than 30 days' notice and is effective on and after October 1, 2015.
