On December 4, 2015, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Black Hills Power, Inc. (BHP) to revise Section 5 (Rules and Regulations) of its South Dakota electric tariff to reflect changes to the line extension policy and secondary service voltage options. BHP requests the tariff revisions become effective on March 1, 2016. On January 27, 2016, and February 2, 2016, BHP responded to Staff's data requests. The revised tariff sheets are as follows:

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to ARSD 20:10:13:26 and SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, and 49-34A-12.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on February 26, 2016, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval of the tariff revisions effective March 1, 2016. Finding the proposed revisions to be just and reasonable, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the tariff revisions. It is therefore

ORDERED, that BHP's request to revise its Section 5 (Rules and Regulations) of its South Dakota electric tariff to reflect changes to the line extension policy and secondary service voltage options is hereby granted. It is further

ORDERED, that the above-mentioned tariff revisions are approved, effective for services rendered on and after March 1, 2016.
