PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR ADOPTION OF PHMSA'S EXERCISE OF ENFORCEMENT DISCRETION ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S REQUEST TO ACCEPT THE EXERCISE OF ENFORCEMENT DISCRETION

On March 26, 2019, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued an exercise of enforcement discretion regarding farm tap inspections. On March 28, 2019, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a letter from its Pipeline Safety Staff (Staff) requesting the Commission "make a ruling on accepting the exercise of enforcement discretion published by PHMSA for as long as PHMSA has the exercise of enforcement discretion in effect." According to the letter, the exercise of enforcement discretion only applies to 49 CFR 192.740 which pertains to farm tap inspections. Staff requests the Commission exercise the same discretion at the state level.

On March 28, 2019, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing with a deadline for initial comments due on April 17, 2019, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No comments were filed. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Ch. 49-34B.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 2, 2019, the Commission discussed this matter. Finding good cause to support the exercise of enforcement discretion, the Commission voted unanimously to grant Staff's request. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Staff 's request to exercise the same discretion as exercised by PHMSA as it pertains to farm tap inspections is hereby granted.
