On June 26, 2013, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Broadvox-CLEC, LLC (Broadvox). This filing proposes to modify Broadvox's switched exchange access tariff, Tariff No. 1, to comply with the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC), November 18, 2011, Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order (FCC 11-161). Broadvox seeks an effective date of July 1, 2013. On August 21, 2013, Broadvox filed its responses to Staff's data requests.

On June 27, 2013, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 12, 2013, to interested individuals and entities. No parties filed to intervene.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of September 10, 2013, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. Commission staff recommended approval of all requested tariff revisions. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the requested revisions to Broadvox's switched exchange access tariff, Tariff No. 1. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above-referenced tariff revisions are approved effective as of July 1, 2013.
