**RE: Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment – August 2024**

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota, Company) herewith respectfully files its fuel and purchased power (F&PP) adjustment pursuant to its Rate 58 tariff.

Exhibit A is the 92<sup>nd</sup> Revised Sheet No. 27.2 showing the proposed Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment to be effective with service rendered on and after August 1, 2024, pursuant to Commission approval.

Exhibit B, page 1 summarizes the fuel and purchased power adjustment calculated pursuant to the terms of Rate 58 authorized in Docket No. EL23-020. The total F&PP adjustment is 1.053 cents per kWh that will apply during the month of August 2024. Pages 2 through 4 show the calculation of the adjustment which is based on a four-month historical average cost of fuel and purchased power.

The net effect of this F&PP adjustment is a reduction from the currently effective rates of 0.673 cents per kWh for service rendered in the month of August 2024.

The per unit decrease is the result of lower purchased power prices in the Regional Transmission Organizations that Montana-Dakota participates, and the credits associated with the Southwest Power Pool Auction Revenue Rights.

All of Montana-Dakota's retail electric customers in South Dakota may be affected by this proposal. There were 8,467 customers in South Dakota as of June 30, 2024.
