Re: Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment – May 2025

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota, Company) herewith respectfully files its fuel and purchased power (F&PP) adjustment to the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission in accordance of its Rate 58 tariff.

Exhibit A, page 1 summarizes the fuel and purchased power adjustment calculated pursuant to the terms of Rate 58 that will apply during the month of May 2025. Pages 2 through 4 show the calculation of the adjustment which is based on a four-month historical average cost of fuel and purchased power.

The net effect of this F&PP adjustment compared to the effective rates is shown below. The per unit decrease was the result of a combination of higher wind generation and a per unit decrease in MISO market prices.
