Dear Ms. Mohr:

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) herewith respectfully submits its Fuel and Purchased Power (F&PP) Adjustment to the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission in accordance with its Rate 58 tariff.

Exhibit A, page 1 summarizes the F&PP Adjustment calculated pursuant to the terms of Rate 58 that will apply during the month of May 2026. Pages 2 through 4 show the calculation of the adjustment which is based on a four-month historical average cost of fuel and purchased power.

The net effect of this F&PP Adjustment compared to the effective rates is shown below. The per unit decrease was largely the result of a per unit decrease in fuel costs due to higher wind generation.
