Re: Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment – August 2026

Dear Ms. Mohr:

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (Montana-Dakota) herewith respectfully submits its Fuel and Purchased Power (F&PP) Adjustment to the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission in accordance with its Rate 58 tariff.

Exhibit A, page 1 summarizes the proposed F&PP Adjustment calculated pursuant to the terms of Rate 58 that will apply during the month of August 2026. Pages 2 through 4 show the calculation of the adjustment which is based on a four-month historical average cost of fuel and purchased power.

The net effect of this F&PP Adjustment compared to the currently effective rates is shown below. The per unit decrease was largely due to lower purchased power costs because of annual Auction Revenue Rights in the Southwest Power Pool (SPP) energy market.
