Motion carried 3-0.

Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Hanson moved a substitute motion to deny the permit. Motion failed 1-2.

Motion carried as amended 2-1. Commissioner Hanson dissenting.

Commissioner Nelson moved to grant City of Sioux Falls and Dakota Access, LLC's Joint Motion regarding Stipulated Finding of Fact, Conditions, and Exhibits filed on October 2,

2015. Motion carried 3-0.
