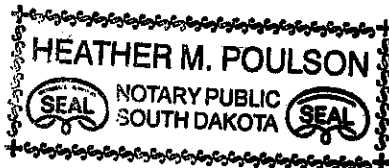

DCL 49-41B-15 and 49-41B-16, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission hold public input hearings at the above times and locations on an Application for Permit filed December 15, 2014, by Dakota Access, LLC (Applicant) for the Dakota project (Application). The Application requests Commission approval of a permit to construct a 30-inch pipeline across approximately 271.6 miles in South Dakota for the purpose of transporting crude oil (Project). The line will cross the South Dakota and North Dakota border at the South Dakota/ Iowa border in Lincoln County. The proposed pipeline capacity of 450,000 barrels of oil per day (bpd) with an anticipated capacity of up to 700,000 bpd. The Project also includes one pump station in South Dakota located approximately 10 miles southeast of Redfield in Spink County.
