**MOTION PURSUANT TO SDCL § 16-18-2 FOR THE *PRO HAC VICE* ADMISSION
OF JENNIFER S. BAKER AS LEGAL COUNSEL FOR YANKTON SIOUX TRIBE IN
PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE SUPREME COURT OF SOUTH DAKOTA**

Under SDCL § 16-18-2, a nonresident attorney, although not licensed to practice law in the State of South Dakota, but licensed in another jurisdiction within the United States, may be admitted for the purpose of participating in the trial or hearing of any particular cause in South Dakota. Jennifer S. Baker, of Fredericks Peebles & Morgan LLP, a nonresident attorney (the "Applicant"), hereby seeks admission *pro hac vice* for the purposes of representing Yankton Sioux Tribe, a party to an appeal pending before the Supreme Court of South Dakota. In support of her motion, the Applicant states:



Yankton Sioux Tribe is a party to an administrative matter before the Public Utility Commission of South Dakota styled *In the Matter of TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP for Order Accepting Certification of Permit Issued in Docket HP09-001 to Construct the Keystone XL Pipeline* (Docket No. 14-001), which is currently on appeal to the Supreme Court of South Dakota. Yankton Sioux Tribe has requested that the Applicant provide representation in this matter, which the Applicant has agreed to provide pending admission to practice before the Supreme Court of the State of South Dakota *pro hac vice*. Applicant was previously admitted to practice before the Public Utilities Commission and the Circuit Court of Hughes County, South Dakota, *pro hac vice*, in the underlying proceedings.


